



A successful Variety

Magdeburg, February 18th 2005. For the fourth time in a row IAONA proves at Hanover Fair that single dedicated Ethernet-Protocols are not only economically and technically the best solution but also that a communication between these single protocols at a high level is no big problem anymore. With the most complex multiple vendor demonstration system in its history, IAONA shows in Hall 11, Stand B 69 an interesting application not only to end users. Each visitor of the show can play with IAONA: A portal crane which is controlled by several Ethernet-protocols can be steered to grab one anti-stress ball.

Besides this application IAONA will present its IAONA Handbook Industrial Ethernet in a revised edition. After the great success of the first edition, the second edition now is published in English. Besides a comprehensive introduction into Industrial Ethernet (with topics such as cabling, communication architectures, security, real-time, wireless and safety) all five protocols of IAONA's partner organizations are shortly sketched: EtherCAT, EtherNet/IP, Ethernet Powerlink, Modbus/TCP and SERCOS-III. Also it contains an enlarged company section.
